BACKGROUND

This program seeks to stimulate the development of promising **young** clinicians and basic researchers (PhDs and/or MDs) working in the field of childhood and adolescent depression, and in the field of ADHD. In particular, the Foundation is interested in supporting young researchers as they gather pilot data, serving as a bridge to secure financial support for potentially larger projects involving federal funding and/or other national research awards (such as a K award from NIMH).

ELIGIBILITY

- Nominees must hold a PhD and/or MD degree and have completed all research training, including postdoctoral training. To clarify, by commencement of the award, **candidates from Yale must be at the rank of associate research scientist, instructor, or** (beginning years as) **assistant professor**.
- Candidates should be planning a career in research related to child and adolescent depression or ADHD.
- Fellows must be sponsored by a mentor who will be expected to monitor and lend his/her support to the fellowship, review the candidate's work, and report on progress; the mentor must have expertise in the candidate's proposed area of research.

FUNDING

- Each award provides \$30,000 per year for 2 years to enable gathering of pilot data.

NOMINATION LIMITATION

- Yale has been invited to nominate one candidate for each of these awards.
